

## **BANNER INSTALL & CARE**

## **Install Between Posts**



Tie the ends of strong rope to a post or other firm item. You can add knots at the length of your banner to keep it from sliding.

Loosely zip-tie or string each banner grommet to the nearest segment of rope.

Make adjustments to the banner placement. Tighten and trim zip-ties once you have your banner where you'd like.

OPTIONAL: Add a bungee cord in the corners to keep the banner taut.

## **Install on Sturdy Substrate**



Check with your local hardware store for fastener recommendations based on the material you plan to mount to.

Measure, drill holes, & install receiving anchors where needed.

Double stick tape may help hold the banner during install

Use fender washers and your mounting fastener through each grommet into the sturdy substrate, building, etc.

## **Basic Banner Care**

When rolling, face graphics inward to protect the image. If you have vinyl text on the banner, roll the image outword.

Hanging a banner only by its corners will add stress to the vinyl, resulting in ripped corners and tears in the graphics.

Wind slits should be cut in the banner before installed on a fence or between posts. Do not fold your Banner.

Keep roll banner stored in a climate controlled room.

Do not exceed temperatures of 120° F or bellow 20° F.

Clean banner with mild soap and water.

Be mindful of city and county ordinances.

Outdoor Banners are a temporary sign solution.

They are great for event planning and short term promotions.

Banners in Montana typically only last one season as a result of our ever-changing weather and conditions.
